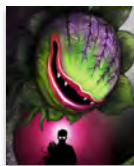

Austin City Limits has begun taping for the show's 47th season, which is scheduled to air this Fall, and welcomes a pair of highly anticipated acts who will make their [ACL debuts](#) on the venerable show's stage. Celebrated musician Jon Batiste will tape on July 17, and acclaimed Texas singer-songwriter Charley Crockett will tape on July 28. Tapings are held at the Moody Theater, 310 W. 2nd Street - Willie Nelson Boulevard, usually in the spring and summer before the season premieres in October of each year. Tickets are not sold to ACLTV tapings, but about a week before each taping, online entry forms are set up [HERE](#) for a chance for the general public to receive passes (given out in pairs) for every show. The link will also be posted on ACLTV's [Facebook](#) and [Twitter](#) accounts. Don't bother entering more than once – any additional entries from the same person will be thrown out. Two or three days before the show, ACLTV will randomly choose the winners and send e-mails. Passes are space available only and do not guarantee admission. Capacity is limited, so follow the time schedule included in the winner notification email. **Please note that tickets are not sold to Austin City Limits TV tapings. Anyone claiming to sell tickets is selling counterfeit tickets.**

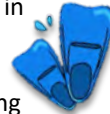

New App for Pool Sharing Worldwide In Houston Now; Coming Soon to Austin & Dallas

It's summertime and the living is easy...if you've got a cool pool to escape the heat. Not that fortunate? [Swimmy](#), a new app that's making quite a splash, could be the answer for you. The app is active in Houston and coming to Austin and Dallas soon. Pools in cities across the country and the world are on the app. Swimmy allows you to rent a pool for half a day without the hassle of pool maintenance. If you're a pool owner, Swimmy can help you recoup those costs or make money by renting it out. Download the app from your phone's app store and follow the instructions to request a booking or to register your pool. Pricing (and amenities) vary by location but is on a per person, half-a-day basis. Adults (ages 12-18 years) are full price, and children (ages 3-12) receive a 50% discount. New Camping This Weekend Option for Quick Reservations

Spur-of-the-moment camping at Texas state parks just got easier. The new **Camping This Weekend** tab on the [Texas State Park's online reservation system](#) shows visitors where tent camping sites, RV/trailer sites and lodging are available for the coming weekend (Friday and Saturday nights). The search results can be narrowed down by park or by city, so if a particular park isn't available, you can find other state parks nearby to explore. The system has also been upgraded to allow spontaneous park goers to make same-day overnight [camping reservations online](#) or by calling the customer service center at 512-389-8900 until 4 p.m. every day. These reservations are only available for camping, including campsites with full hookup, electricity, and water.
